We will be learning to:


- Attaching materials to a base securely.

- Paint with good technique, ensuring good coverage.

Science: Everyday Materials

We will be learning to:

- Investigate different objects & understand that they are made from a material
- Identify natural & manmade materials & their uses
- Use observations about materials to make decisions about their use for different purposes & explain why
- Perform simple tests to investigate questions e.g. what is the best material for a dog basket & why?



PE: Attacking and Defending

We will be learning to:

- Apply simple attacking and defending techniques:
 - quick changes of direction
 - changes of speeds
- Have an awareness of others and space
- Use effective uses of changes of direction and speed
- Participate in team games, which develop simple tactics for attacking and defending
- Compete against others as individuals and in small teams
- Maintain control and balance whilst competing against others
- Begin to contribute to discussions and suggest some tactics to improve
- Begin to play with confidence and a freedom to take risks.

Computer Science: Algorithm

We will be learning to:

- Debug a simple program causing an unexpected outcome
- Predict the outcome of a simple program
- Break a problem down into smaller parts



PSHE & Relationships Education: Health & Prevention

We will be learning about

- About dental health & the benefits of good oral hygiene & dental flossing, including regular check-ups at the dentist
- About personal hygiene & germs including bacteria, viruses, how they are spread & treated, & the importance of handwashing
- To recognise how medicines help if we feel poorly & the importance of keeping them in a locked cupboard
- How to use the internet & digital devices safely under the supervision of an adult

PSHE & Relationships Education: Growing & Changing

We will be learning to about:

- How facial expressions can show how we & others feel & how to respond to this

Music: Exploring Sounds

We will be learning to:

- Exploring how sounds can be changed
- Exploring the timbre of instruments and voices
- Sequencing sounds to tell stories and create effects
- Copying and creating rhythmic patterns



Topic: Great Explorers

We will be learning to:

- Identify important people in our lives & explore what it means to be a significant person
- Research one of the first great explorers, Ibn Battuta
- Find out about Christopher Columbus
- Find out about Neil Armstrong
- Recognise how we know & can find out more about these explorers
- Understand what happened to Captain Scott & his companions
- Recognise how & why these explorers are remembered



R.E: The Easter Story

We will be learning to:

- Understand the events of the Easter Story
- Explore how Easter is celebrated
- Make connections between Easter & spring
- Recognise the main Easter traditions
- Understand how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' death in the church at Easter
- Explore the concepts of hope & sadness & how they are important to the lives of Christians & those who are not Christians
