

Art: Sculpture & 3D- Clay Houses

We will be learning to:

- Flatten and smooth their clay, rolling shapes and making a range of marks in their clay.
- Make a basic pinch pot and join at least one clay shape onto the side using the scoring and slipping technique.
- Roll a smooth tile surface.
- Join clay shapes and make marks in the tile surface to create a pattern.
- Draw a house design and plan how to create the key features in clay.
- Create a clay house tile that has recognisable features made by both pushing objects into the surface and by joining simple shapes.
