

Year 3 Multiplication Tables Check Parent & Carer Meeting

You are invited to attend a multiplication tables meeting on **Thursday 17th September at 2:45pm in the Rainbow Retreat** (please use the main entrance where a year 6 prefect will guide you to the meeting room).

At the meeting, you will be given information about the multiplication tables check (MTC) your child will be completing in when they are in Year 4. The purpose is to determine whether children can fluently recall multiplication facts up to 12, which are essential to future success in mathematics, and identify where any additional support is needed.

The sessions will provide more information on the content of the check, how it is carried out and how we will prepare the children so they are ready to complete the check next year. You will also be given resources to help you to support your child at home in preparation for the check.

We strongly encourage you to attend the meeting. However, all children will bring home a printout of the information shared at the meeting in case you are unable to attend.
